



## Notice of Race 2010 National Championship Regatta

### 1. Rules:

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing, 2009-2012*.

### 2. Advertising

No advertising will be permitted other than that permitted or required per ISAF Regulation 20. The Catalina 22 National Sailing Association does not permit additional advertising as outlined in ISAF Regulation 20.3.1.2 (ISAF Regulation 20.5.7).

### 3. Bow Numbers

Bow numbers will be assigned at check in. Bow numbers must be placed within 24 inches from the leading edge of the bow, measured from the bow eye.

### 4. Eligibility:

Participation in Catalina 22 Class regattas in the capacity of skipper/helmsman shall be limited to owners of Catalina 22 sloops and their immediate families, who also will be members of the Catalina 22 National Sailing Association in good standing.

### 5. Classes:

There will be three Fleets as defined below with a minimum of five boats registered to make a fleet.

- A. Genoa Gold Fleet – Open to all Skippers eligible to sail in the regatta. The winner will be the 2010 National Champion.
- B. Genoa Silver Fleet – Limited to skippers who have not received a first place trophy in any Catalina 22 state, regional or national regatta
- C. Spinnaker Fleet – must also be registered in either Gold or Silver Genoa Class.

### 6. Registration & Fees:

The registration form and associated fees will be published in the January 2010 issue of the *MainBrace* magazine and available on the Privateer Yacht Club web site ([www.privateeryachtclub.org](http://www.privateeryachtclub.org)) and the Catalina 22 National Association Website ([www.catalina22.org](http://www.catalina22.org)) no later than February 1, 2010. Early registration will close on April 30<sup>th</sup>, 2010. A late fee will be assessed after that date. Registration will close on May 16<sup>th</sup>, 2010. Receipt of registration will be determined by the postmark on the envelope or when received by the Registrar if hand delivered.

**8. Measurement:**

- A. Each Boat shall comply with the Catalina 22 one design Rules and produce a valid measurement Certificate before close of registration at 11:00 AM Sunday May 16<sup>th</sup>, 2010.
- B. All Sails must be measured according to C22 one Design Rules.
- C. Section H (Required Safety Equipment) of the C22 One Design Rules will be enforced. All boats will be inspected for compliance. An inspection may be performed at any time during the regatta.

**9. Sailing Instructions:**

The sailing instructions will be provided in the Skipper's Packet at the registration Desk at Joe Wheeler Lodge.

**10. Racing Area:**

The racing area will be on Joe Wheeler Lake in the vicinity of the mouth of 1<sup>st</sup> Creek.

**11. Course:**

The courses to be sailed will be a Windward/Leeward. An offset mark will be used and a leeward gate will be provided should the conditions warrant it.

**12. Scoring:**

The low Point Scoring System of Appendix A will apply. All Scores will be counted. Seven races will be scheduled for the Gold and Silver Fleets, with three races constituting a regatta. Four races will be scheduled for the Spinnaker Fleet, with one race constituting a regatta.

**13. Haul-Out Restrictions**

Boats shall not be hauled out during the regatta except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the race committee PRO.

**14. Prizes:**

Awards of first, second, third, fourth, and fifth will be awarded to all fleets. The Betty Gay Clements perpetual trophy will be awarded to the highest placing female skipper in accordance with its deed.

**15. Insurance**

All boats are required to hold \$100,000 third party insurance. It is the owner or owner's representative's sole responsibility to ensure that the insurance is in place and is adequate.

**16. Amendments to the Notice of Race**
