Notice of Race and Registration**

Privateer Yacht Club and Fleet 95 are proud to host the 2018 Chattanooga Challenge Regatta. We hope you enjoy your visit to Chattanooga. If you need anything during your stay, don't hesitate to ask any of the local Fleet 95 members.

1. Rules

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the one design rules of the Catalina 22 National Sailing Association.

2. Venue

The regatta will be held on Lake Chickamauga in the vicinity of Privateer Yacht Club, in Hixson, TN.

3. Eligibility and Entry

3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Catalina 22 Class. All Catalina 22s are invited to attend and will be eligible for the overall fleet awards.

3.2 The Tennessee State Champion Award is open only to Catalina 22 skippers who are members of a Tennessee fleet.

3.3 Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and submitting it with the required fees by the close of the registration table on April 30, 2016.

Note: If possible, early submission of entry forms (prior to April 30th) will be greatly appreciated, as better event planning is possible.

4. Fees

See the entry form below for the required fees.

5. Races

Five races are planned for the regatta, with three on Saturday and two on Sunday. One race constitutes a regatta. Additional races may be held on Saturday if time and weather permit.

6. Scoring

The low point system, RRS A4, will apply, except that each boat's final score will be the sum of her scores for all races. No throw-outs will be scored.

7. Schedule (All times are Eastern Daylight Time)

Club gate open for the duration of the regatta.

9:00am Registration table opens

11:00am Competitors meeting. Registration closes.

11:30am Lunch. (Bring your own)

12:00pm Warning signal for Gold Fleet. Silver Fleet to follow, additional races to follow as soon as possible, conditions permitting.

7:00pm Dinner and Social. We will again have the Irish Pot Roast Dinner prepared by Kathy Robertson, Faye Ives, Beverly Bergevin, and Sandy Rathjen. Don't miss it!

9:30am Warning signal for Gold Fleet race. Silver Fleet to follow.
No races will start after 12:00 pm.

8. Measurement

Boats may be randomly inspected by the Fleet 95 Measurer for compliance with Catalina 22 One Design Rules.

9. Radio Communication

Radios are not required. However, as a convenience, some racing signals may be supplemented by radio communication as determined by the Race Committee.

Failure to hear any broadcast will not be considered grounds for redress. Radio communication will be on Channel 72.

10. Sailing Instructions

The sailing instructions will be available at the Registration Table when it opens on Saturday May 5th, 2018. They will include the courses to be sailed with diagrams.

11. Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The race organizers will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

Directions to the Privateer Yacht Club, 4713 Privateer Road, Hixson, TN 37343:

From I-24 South:

Take I-24 South to I-75 North, and then follow directions from I-75 below.

From I-75 North or South

Exit I-75 to Highway 153 North. Follow Highway 153 North approximately 6.8 miles across Chickamauga Dam. Immediately at the north end of the dam, exit at Lake Resort Drive. Go fully around the traffic circle and turn onto Lake Resort Drive. Follow Lake Resort Drive approximately 1.5 miles to the intersection with Gann Store Road. (Look for small "PYC" signs) Turn right on Gann Store Road. Follow Gann Store Road, past Gold Point Marina, approximately 1.1 miles. At the top of a hill, where Gann Store Road turns left, go straight onto Privateer Road. At the end of the cul-de-sac on Privateer Road is the entrance gate to the Club.
