



2013 TVCC Club Nautical Challenge Rules

1. Participants
 - a. Each TVCC member and guest club may enter one team
 - b. Each team is allowed a maximum of 3 active persons
 - c. Each team member must be a member of the respective sailing club
 - d. Teams may rotate members as they see fit
 - e. Teams must designate a captain (spokesperson who will answer)
 - f. Team captain will wear appropriate "Captains hat".
 - g. Captains hat will be provided by LGSC
2. Game Rules
 - a. Nautical questions will be chosen and read aloud by the Moderator
 - b. Time limit of the game is approximately one hour
 - c. There will be two formats for answering questions
 - d. Format one: 45 minutes duration
 - i. Each team will have an electrical switch that they may activate if they know the answer
 - ii. First team to enable their switch will have to opportunity to answer the question. Sophisticated electronic circuitry designed by rocket engineers will determine which team was first to enable their switch. The Moderator will have the final decision on the selection.
 - iii. The selected team will have 5 seconds to provide the answer. If an answer is not provided in 5 seconds then the team forfeits the question. The Moderator's decision is final in determining the time forfeit.
 - e. Format two: 15 minutes
 - i. Each team will have an opportunity to answer the given question
 - ii. 15 seconds timeframe for an answer
 - iii. Answers to be written down and read aloud
 - f. Moderator may increase or decrease the time allocated for format one and two at his discretion
 - g. Moderator may make adjustments to the rules
3. Scoring
 - a. Each correct answer is worth 1 point
 - b. Each incorrect answer will deduct 1 point
 - c. If a non-active member yells out the answer, then that club will be penalized by the deduction of 1 point

- d. At the end of the regulation time period, the team with the most points is the Champion
- e. If there is a tie at the end of regulation, then an overtime period begins for the teams that are tied:
 - i. Teams competing in the overtime period must answer each question
 - ii. 15 seconds timeframe for an answer
 - iii. A team that provides an incorrect answer is then dismissed
 - iv. Last team to answer correctly is the Champion

4. Awards A trophy plaque and the bragging rights for 2013 will be awarded
